Now upon hearing Mr. M.A. Latif Prodhan, Advocate For the Petitioner Mr. Bipul Bagmar, DAG with Mr. Bahauddin Ahmed, AAG, Mr. Mohammed Rezaul Hoque, AAG, Mr. Selim Azad, AAG and Mr. Md. Serajul Islam, AAG For the respondents and upon consideration of the said petition this Court doth order and do issue a Rule Nisi calling upon you the aforesaid respondents to show cause on or before the 12<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022, as to why the inaction of the respondents in not considering the petitioner's applications dated 23.08.2022 (Annexures- L & L-1) for re-staring the freedom fighter's allowance of the petitioner's husband from the month of November, 2016 should not be declared to have been done without lawful authority and is of no legal effect and /or to pass such other or further order or orders as to this Court may seem fit and proper.

The petitioner is directed to put in two sets of requisites for service of notices both in usual course as well as through registered post within 3 working days.
